We re-engaged the dormant Facebook page and re-purposed our Tuesday Cafe time slot to focus on moms and toddlers.

It's a wonderful time full of irresistible energy. The Lord has been steadily growing the number of children and moms. It's heartwarming to see the older ones (3-4 years old) bound up the ramp into the church, excited to get inside to toys and friends. Most of the moms walk to church, and even though it has turned cold, they say, "I'm just happy to get outside and take the bairn for a wee walk."

Another Opportunity Beckons

We have no photographic evidence - you'll have to take our word on it - but Peter and I are able to do school assemblies at the primary school where Sheryl volunteers. The Head Teacher (Principal) noted incidents of bullying and name-calling. So, we did a short talk from James 3:3-5 with the visual aids of a ship's rudder, a horse's bit, and a fire starter, culminating with the gospel. The schools are required to teach about religion, but nobody in the school goes to church, so they generally "outsource" it. As long as you preface what you say with, "What Christians believe is...," you can say just about anything. And we do especially the gospel. It's a marvelous opportunity, and it has resulted in families coming to our invitation events.

Speaking of invitation events:

We recently had a week of outreach events including a magic show by an "Illusionist" who is also a Free Church Minister. He spoke of Truth vs Illusion - an obvious lead in to the Gospel.



Finally - A New Tradition Continues


